Ludwig Hill's score orienteering course kicked off the autumn orienteering season in Tucson urban style on the University of Arizona campus. A total of 29 control points were scattered throughout the campus map, bounded between 6th Street, Speedway, Euclid and Campbell. Along with their map, each orienteer carried a questionnaire with a choice of answers to demonstrate visiting the controls. Typical questions asked were "How many boulders are in the raised flowerbed?".

Each control visited and answered correctly was worth 10 points. A penalty of -10 points was taken for incorrect answers or for each minute or fraction of each minute taken after the 90-minute time limit. Our top finisher **Jeff Brodsky** managed to visit all 29 controls, but with others close on his heels. A couple of finishers came in after the time limit and lost points. For everyone, there was the challenge of picking routes and determining the best order to visit controls.
